Open and Closed Syllables: VCCV, VCV

Generalization:

The syllable break in words with the **VCCV** spelling pattern occurs between the two and double consonants (sur-vive, ap-pear). In words with the **VCV** spelling pattern, a consonant between two vowels tends to go with the second vowel unless the first vowel is accented and short (open syllable: bro-ken; closed syllable: wag-on).
